Program Purpose

- * To encourage technical training for graduating high school seniors.
- * To educate youth about careers in their own communities.

Eligibility Guidelines

1. High school seniors may apply for the \$500 scholarship.
2. The student should be planning to attend an Electrical Power Distribution Program at one of the five Wisconsin Technical Colleges that offer courses:
 - Blackhawk Technical College (Janesville)
 - Chippewa Valley Technical College (course held in Eau Claire)
 - Milwaukee Area Technical College
 - Moraine Park Technical College (course held in Beaver Dam)
 - Northeast Wisconsin Technical College (Green Bay)
 - Southwest Tech (Fennimore, WI)
3. A letter of recommendation is required from a teacher, counselor or employer that addresses the applicant's skills that are pertinent to the job (i.e., manually dexterous, in good physical condition, willing to work at all heights and in all weather, able to comprehend and follow written instructions, safety conscious).
4. The deadline for submitting applications is April 1, 2012. The scholarship recipient will be announced in May.
5. To be eligible, the student, their parent or their legal guardian must be a customer of Two Rivers Water & Light.
