SCHOLARSHIP INFORMATION

Eligibility Guidelines

1. High school seniors may submit an essay to win a \$500 scholarship. To be eligible, the student's parent(s) or legal guardian(s) must be a customer of Two Rivers Water and Light when the essay is submitted. Dependents of Two Rivers Water and Light employees are not eligible.
2. The theme of the essay is: **How could you be more energy efficient in your daily life and what difference would it make?** The essay should be 500 to 1,000 words, typed and double spaced. A cover page with the following information should be included:
 - Student's first and last name, home address and telephone number
 - Name of student's parent(s) or legal guardian(s)
 - Two Rivers Water and Light account information including the name on the account, billing address and account number
 - Name of High School you are attending
3. The deadline for submitting an essay is April 1, 2012. Please bring your essay to the Two Rivers Water and Light office or mail it to:
