The theme for the 2018 Two Rivers Water & Light Energy Conference was “**emPOWERing YOU**”. Frank Barth explained how businesses can save on energy costs by knowing when their business has energy spikes and then work to spread the energy consumption out. When possible, moving some of the load to the off-peak time periods can be very beneficial.

Ken Kozak and Ross Blaha updated the group on many projects completed and future in the City and how the Electric, Water and Waste Water Departments are working to improve reliability, public and employee safety, and efficiency.



Ken Kozak presented Ross Blaha with an Incentive Check for LED improvements made to the Water Filter Plant. This project saves the Filter Plant about 12,500 Kilowatt Hours a year, which will reduce the plants energy costs about \$1,700 yearly.
